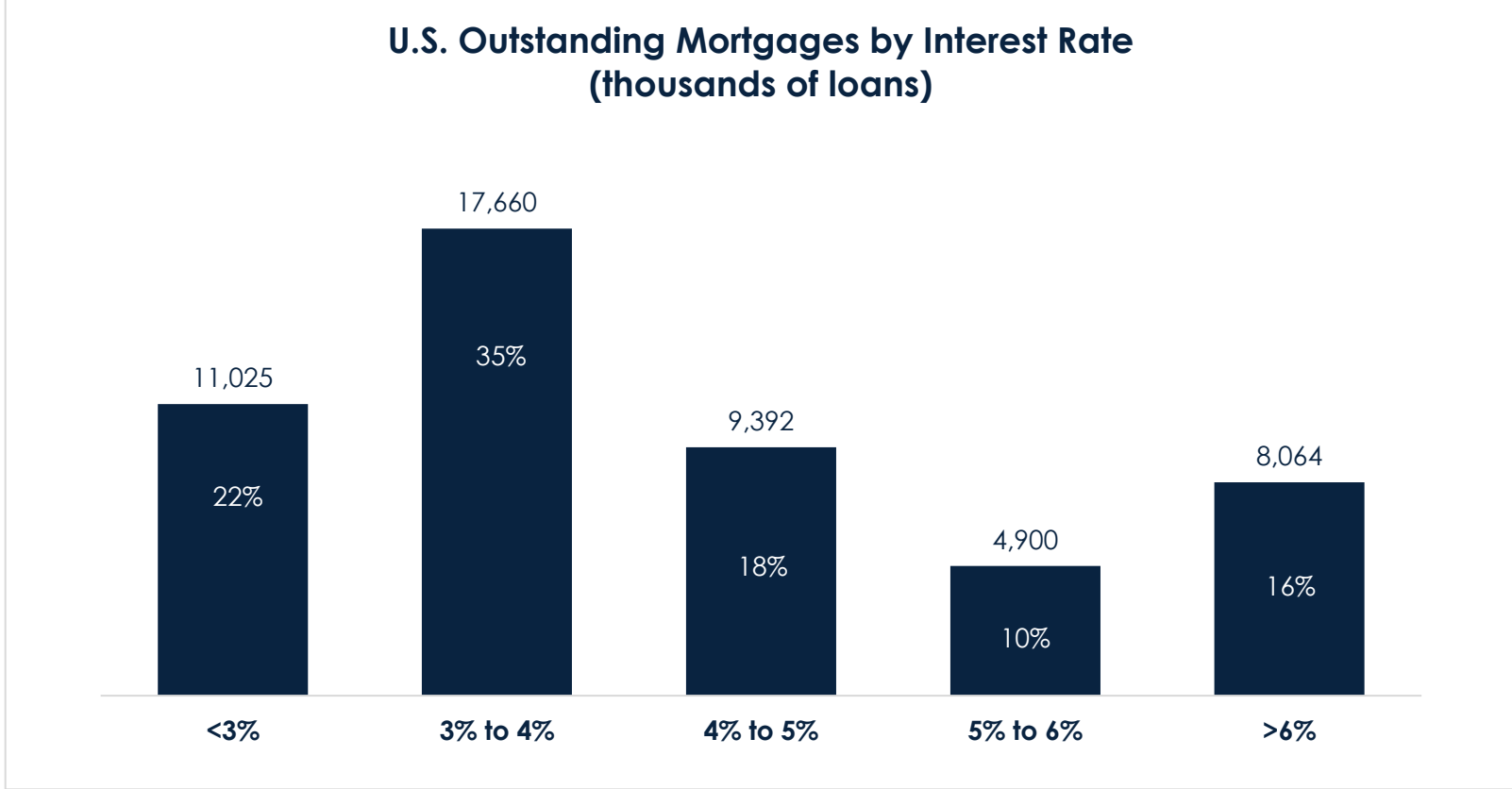
Fiscal 2024 Highlights

- Continued to prudently manage costs throughout the year to align with variability in mortgage origination volumes – demonstrated how relative change in the rate environment can translate into improved margins and profitability.
- Strong operating leverage:
 - Consolidated Net Revenue¹ increased by \$3.3M YoY to \$46.4M and Adjusted EBITDA¹ was up \$4.2M to \$1.9M
 - 87% conversion of Net Revenue to Adjusted EBITDA¹ in U.S. Appraisal
 - 100% conversion of net revenue to Adjusted EBITDA¹ in U.S. Title
- Launched 16 new clients and 4 new channels
- YoY market share gains with our clients in all three segments
- Strong balance sheet: \$49.1 million in cash and no debt

U.S. Appraisal

- Revenues +8% YoY due to market share increases with our clients and higher addressable refinance origination market volumes
- Net Revenue¹ +6% YoY and Net Revenue¹ margin of 26.7% (within Target Operating Model range)
- Adjusted EBITDA¹ +4% YoY as higher Net Revenue¹ was offset by inflationary adjustments to compensation

U.S. Title

- Revenues +4% YoY due to market share increases with our Tier 1 lender and higher addressable origination refinance market volumes
- Net Revenue¹ +15% YoY, Net Revenue¹ margins increased to 49.8% due to distribution of transaction volumes (geography, client and product mix)
- Adjusted EBITDA¹ of \$(1.6)M – flat from Q4'23 as higher Net Revenue¹ was offset by inflationary adjustments to compensation
- Launched three new clients

Canada

- Revenues +8% YoY due to higher market volume and market share gains with our clients
- Net Revenue¹ +14% YoY, near-record Net Revenue¹ margins of 18.9%
- Adjusted EBITDA¹ of \$1.2M vs. \$1.1M in Q4'23
- Launched three new clients and one new channel
